INTRODUCTION

Suzhou is the economic, trading and logistic centre as well as the second-largest city in the Jiangsu province. The city is surrounded by water, canals, stone bridges and beautifully designed gardens have contributed to the status as one of the top tourist attractions in China, also known as "Venice of China" or "Venice of the east".

Furthermore, the city is listed on the UNESCO world heritage sites in 1997 and 2000. located on the lower part of the Yangtze river and the shores of Lake Tai.

CULTURE



Suzhou has over 2,500 years of rich history. It became one of the ten largest cities in the world. Since the 10th century Song Dynasty, it has been an important commercial centre of China. The city's canals, stone bridges, pagodas, and meticulously designed gardens have contributed to its status as one of the top tourist attractions in China.

The city also have many other features such as: Li Gong Di, Jin Ji Lake recreational & commercial zone, Yang Cheng Lake Hairy Crab and Tiger Hill.

HISTORY & NATURAL



For most of the tourist attractions, there is an entrance ticket required, although some ancient commercial streets such as Shan Tang Street and Ping Jiang Road are free for sightseeing. The classical gardens in Suzhou were added to the list of the UNESCO world heritage sites in 1997 and 2000.

Other ancient places in Suzhou include: Gusu District which contains most of the historical scenery spots in the city. Suzhou has a very sacred area which was originally built in 276 and it's a prominent Taoist temple with a long history, located a the centre of old Suzhou city.

C U I S I N E



If you are visiting Suzhou somewhere between mid-September and the end of December then you should definitely try Suzhou's hairy crab. The crab will be harvested from the Yangcheng Lake nearby Suzhou in this period of the year. The hairy crab from this lake is world famous because of its top quality and a sweeter taste compared with other crabs. Zhang Taiyan, a famous scholar that lived in Suzhou said once: "If hairy crabs of the Yangcheng Lake were not so wonderful, why do we have to live in Suzhou?". Try it out!

Growth

- Suzhou's GDP surpassed 329 billion USD in 2022.
- GDP growth rate of more than 3.2%, rank No.2 in China 2nd tier cities.
- Suzhou's economy is based primarily on its large manufacturing sector- China's second largest including: iron and steel, IT and electronic equipment and textile.


Suzhou Industrial Park

- The Suzhou industrial park (SIP) is the largest cooperative project between the Chinese and Singaporean government. It is beside Jinji Lake, which lies to the east of the Suzhou old city.

- the Suzhou Industrial Park Free Trade Zone(FTA) was approved to be established by the government in December 2018, with a planning area of 66 Km sq.


CITY MAP



Suzhou is divided into 7 districts. The two most important districts are: ancient district and industrial park.

Ancient District was named Gusu district and most of the historical scenery spots are located in this area. This district has areas such as: the Shan Tang Street and Ping Jiang Road are free for sight-seeing.

INDUSTRIAL PARK



Industrial Park is the largest cooperative project between the Chinese and Singaporean government. It is beside Jinji Lake, which lies to the east of the Suzhou old city.



- Operating hours: 6:00 to 23:00
- Price: 2- 6 RMB (bus passes can be used on the metro as well)

B U S

Regular Lines

- Suzhou has 4 major long distance bus terminals; they are all located in the downtown, south, north, west part of Suzhou, except ease part of Suzhou which is SIP.

4 major terminals

Suzhou north long distance bus station (nearer to Suzhou railway station)

- Cost: 30 RMB per 9km
- Duration: 20 min. (normal) / 40 min. (peak)

Suzhou south long distance bus station(downtown Suzhou)

- Cost: 30 RMB per 9km
- Duration: 20 min. (normal) / 45 min. (peak)

Suzhou new district long distance bus station (Suzhou west long distance bus station)

- Cost: 65 RMB per 20km
- Duration: 30 min. (normal) / 60 min. (peak)

Wuzhong district long distance bus station (south of Suzhou)

- Cost: 45 RMB per 15 km
- Duration: 30 min. (normal) / 60 min. (peak)

ΤΑΧΙ

- Taxis is a safe and easy method of travel for expats. The flag- fall price of the common taxis is 13 RMB. After the initial 3km, It will charge passenger 2.5 RMB per km.
- If a taxi runs around 23:00 5:00 the next day, night allowance is required, for which you need to pay extra 20% when the distance is over 3km.
- Alternatives are DiDi ,CAO CAO and T3, which often offer cheaper rides in better quality cars.

TRANSPORT CARD

Transport Card

- Can be purchased at several subway and bus stations in Suzhou
- 18 RMB non-refundable deposit + travel value
- Can be charged at many subway and bus stations

HOUSING




- Apartments, townhouses and villas in both western and traditional styles can be found.
