




INTRODUCTION

Tianjin is a municipality and a coastal metropolis in Northern China on the shore of Bohai Sea, it is one of the nine national central cities in Mainland China, with a total population of 15,621,200 as of 2016 estimation. Its built-up (or metro) area, made up of 12 central districts (all but Baodi, Jizhou, Jinghai and Ninghe), was home to 12,491,300 inhabitants in 2016 and is also the world's 29th-largest agglomeration (between Chengdu and Rio de Janeiro) and 11th-most populous city proper.

Tianjin's population as of 2018 is just over 15.6 million. The average temperature in the summer is usually more than 26° in July. Winter is cool with an average of -1.6°. The total GDP of Tianjin was over 446.6 billion USD in 2018.

CULTURE



Tianjin is a provincial level municipality of China, ranking the third largest urban land area after Beijing and Shanghai. It is the only city in China that has the exact record of city construction. With a history of more than 600 years, Tianjin created a uniquely compatible urban style, Chinese and Western, ancient and modern. Tianjin is a cultural city with many different folk customs such as Xiangsheng, a popular form of entertainment similar to comedy, and Yangliuqing colourful wash painting, a form of traditional-style woodcut painting.

HISTORY & NATURAL



Tianjin is the fourth largest in China, after Shanghai, Beijing, and Guangzhou. In terms of administrative area population, Tianjin ranks fifth in Mainland China. The walled city of Tianjin was built in 1404. As a treaty port since 1860, Tianjin has been a major seaport and gateway to Beijing. During the Boxer Rebellion the city was the seat of the Tianjin Provisional Government. Under the Qing dynasty and the Republic of China, Tianjin became one of the largest cities in the region. At that time, numerous European-style buildings and mansions were constructed in concessions, many of which are well-preserved today.


CUISINE



Tianjin is derived from the native cooking styles of Tianjin Municipality, a metropolis along the coast of northern China. It is heavily influenced by Beijing cuisine, due to its proximity, but differs by being sweeter, and more heavy focused on seafood. Tianjin Food Street is a place where cross-cultural Chinese dishes can be sampled.

Popular dishes include Eight Great Bowls, Four Great Stews, Tianjing goubuli, and guifaxiang mahua, among others. Eight Great Bowls is a combination of eight mainly meat dishes. It can be further classified into several varieties, including the rough, smooth, and high.

ATTRACTIONS

Tianjin has its own distinct character that makes it stand out from any other Chinese metropolis. Thousands of colonial buildings from the 19th and early 20th-century foreign powers, along with multiple relics from centuries of traditional Chinese culture, are either still intact or have been recreated.

The Century Clock

The Century Clock is right off the Haihe River and is visible from the Tianjin Train Station. This will likely be the first, or last, Tianjin attraction you will see while visiting. Each zodiac sign is represented alongside a numeral.

Tianjin Eye

The most noted attraction in Tianjin, the Tianjin Eye is the only Ferris Wheel in the world to be atop a bridge. Lines don't take too long, and the views are unrivaled. Make sure to go on a clear day.


Italian-Style Town

- Tianjin metro has 8 lines, making it very fast and convenient to travel around the city. There is another 12 lines in planning of construction.
- The ticket fare ranges from 2-11 RMB depending on distance travelled.

TAXI


- Regular taxis will take passengers anywhere in the city with a starting price of 10rmb for the first 2 kilometers and 2rmb per additional kilometer.
- When a journey is longer than 10 kilometers, taxis charge an additional 50% on the price per kilometer for an empty return.
- Passengers can also use the Didi app, which often offers more affordable rides in better quality cars.


- Apartments, townhouses and villas in both western and traditional styles can be found.
